ADOPTION OF THE LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE FOR THE CHIPPEWA-EAU CLAIRE METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA 2010-2030.

WHEREAS, the Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) was designated by the Governor of the State of Wisconsin for the purpose of carrying out cooperative, comprehensive, and continuing urban transportation planning in the Eau Claire urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the MPO adopted the *Long Range Transportation Plan for the Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Area 2005-2030*, on March 1, 2006, and a USDOT required amendment on October 3, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the *Long Range Transportation Plan Update for the Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Area 2010-2030* (Plan Update) is an update to that plan adopted in 2006, and was prepared to meet the requirements of The Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users, as prescribed in the U.S. Code, Title 23 Section 134, and in accordance with joint regulation issued by the Federal Highway Administration (23 CFR Parts 450 and 500) and Federal Transit Administration (49 CFR Part 613) - Statewide Transportation Planning; Metropolitan Transportation Planning, July 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Update will meet the required twenty-year plan horizon (at time of adoption), as well as the five-year update requirement; and

WHEREAS, the planning process has been consistent with the MPO's formally adopted Public Involvement Process, and consultation procedures of the USDOT; and


WHEREAS, the Plan Update considers all modes of transportation and reflects the forecast growth, land use and transportation plans, goals, objectives, and policies of the member communities; and


