Public Involvement Opportunities

Public involvement opportunities in the development of the Long Range Transportation Plan were initiated in the winter of 2020 with Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Policy Council meetings. Specific meeting dates and agendas for these early public involvement opportunities are available upon request from the Chippewa-Eau Claire MPO. Public involvement opportunities to review and comment on the development of the draft document up to the adoption of the final plan are listed in the following chronological order:

- January 8, 2025 – TAC meeting to review LRTP update regarding schedule, public participation process, and TAC responsibilities.
- January 29, 2025 – MPO meeting to review LRTP schedule, public participation process, and TAC and Policy Council responsibilities.
- January 29, 2025 – Press release and public notices notifying public on LRTP update, online public survey, three open houses, and contact information.
- January 14, 2025 – Online public survey open until March 14.
- March 04, 06, 11, 2025 – Open houses in Altoona, Eau Claire, and Chippewa Falls
- April 16, 2025 – TAC meeting to review goals, objectives, and strategies and review public online survey results.
- May 07, 2025 – MPO meeting to review goals, objectives, and strategies and review public online survey results.
- August 13, 2025 – TAC meeting to review goals, objectives, and strategies, and data.
- August 27, 2025 – MPO meeting to review goals, objectives, and strategies, and data.
- September 17, 2025 – TAC meeting to finalize final draft of LRTP.
- October 08, 2025 – MPO meeting to finalize final draft of LRTP.
- December 1, 2025 – Memo to environmental consultation contact list and environmental justice contact list requesting their review and comment on the Draft Long Range Transportation Plan.
- December 1, 2025 – February 3, 2026 – Long Range Transportation Plan Public Review Period.
- January 14, 2026 – TAC meeting to consider any public input, recommend appropriate revisions, and recommend approval of LRTP.
- February 4, 2026 – Public Hearing and MPO meeting approve LRTP.

Opportunity to Provide Public Input on the Future of Transportation in the Chippewa-Eau Claire Urbanized Area

*The Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Organization is updating the current
MPO 2020-2045 Long Range Transportation Plan*

The Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is in the process of updating the area's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). The development and update (every five years) of the Long Range Transportation Plan is required under the federal transportation legislation. The planning area includes the cities of Altoona, Chippewa Falls, and Eau Claire; the Village of Lake Hallie; portions of the towns of Anson, Eagle Point, Hallie, Lafayette, Tilden, and Wheaton, in Chippewa County; and Brunswick, Pleasant Valley, Seymour, Union, and Washington, in Eau Claire County.

The process for updating the LRTP is currently in the early stages. MPO staff would like to hear what area residents think about the current transportation system in the region, as well as what they would like to see in the future. There are several ways that the public can give input. There will be three public open houses and an online survey. Open houses will allow people to comment on transportation issues and opportunities. The online survey can be found at www.surveymonkey.com/r/mpo2025. The survey will be open until March 23rd.

The Draft Long Range Transportation Plan for the Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Area (2025-2055) will be considered for adoption by MPO Council at their meeting immediately following the public hearing.

The plan is multi-modal, addressing pedestrian, bicycle, transit, highway, freight trucking, and freight and passenger rail in the metropolitan planning area. The plan is required to maintain transportation funding eligibility for the urbanized area and its municipalities.
